## The Niki of Today

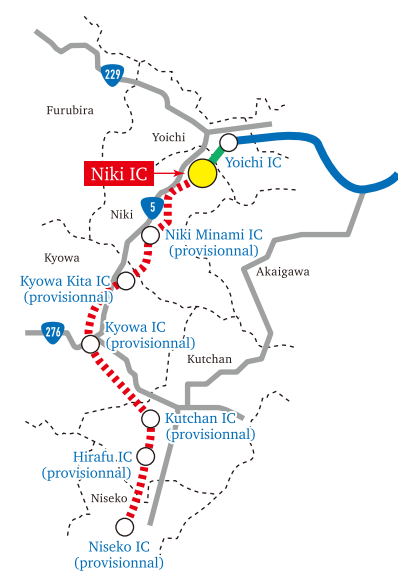
Niki Town has long utilized its ideal climate and location to produce a wide variety of fruits. Among these, cherries stand out as the most prominent crop, boasting the highest cultivation area and production volume in Hokkaido. They are also a popular gift choice in Japan's hometown tax donation system. Recently, we have branded our Shine Muscat grapes under the name "La · La · shine." As the northernmost Shine Muscat production area in Japan, Niki is making exciting progress in this field. The advanced cultivation techniques developed through our fruit farming have also been applied to growing cherry tomatoes. With the highest production volume in Hokkaido, Niki is recognized as one of Japan's leading producers. Since being designated as the Niki Wine Special Zone in 2017, our wine industry has flourished, with new wineries and vineyards emerging. These establishments collaborate to host events, helping Niki grow as a unique wine-producing region.

## History of Niki Town

- 1879 • Niki Takeyoshi settles in Niki Village from Tokushima's Awa Province
- 1880 • Niki village becomes officially established
- 1884 • Apple cultivation begins in Niki; rice farming begins in Oe Village
- 1902 • Niki, Oe, and Sando Villages merge to form Oe Village
- 1964 • Oe Village is renamed Niki and designated as a town
- 1968 • Grape cultivation for winemaking begins
- 1974 • Niki signs a sister-town agreement with Kawashima Town in Tokushima (now Yoshinogawa City)
- 1984 • Commencement of the 1st Cherry Festival
- 1987 • Sun Sports Land Niki (now Consadole Niki Park) opens
- 2001 • Fruit Park Niki opens
- 2017 • Niki Wine Special Zone designated as a Cabinet Office Special Reform Zone

## Becoming a Must-Visit Destination

The section of the Shiribeshi Expressway connecting Niki Interchange to Yoichi Interchange opened in 2025 and the Hokkaido Shinkansen is expected to extend to Sapporo in the near future. Working together with neighboring municipalities like Otaru, Yoichi, and Niseko, we are striving to create an attractive region that welcomes both domestic and international visitors.

The shrine's original wine-themed lucky charms are also very popular.

Niki is ideal for cultivating wine grapes.

Why not take an extraordinary journey to explore the winemaking process and the unique atmosphere of the wineries?



## Soba and Japanese Wine in Asahidai, Niki Town

In Asahidai, Niki Town, surrounded by vineyards with a view of Mt. Chohaku, enjoy handmade thin-cut soba made with stone-ground Hokkaido buckwheat flour, prized for its aroma and smooth texture. Pair your meal with local wines or a selection of Japanese wines, offering a perfect combination with the soba.

### Capturing the Essence of Asahidai's Clear Atmosphere

A white wine primarily composed of Chardonnay and Pinot Gris. Made using wild yeast and the natural power of grapes, it features aromas of green apple, pear, citrus, chamomile-like white flowers, and hints of black sugar, with a subtle bitterness in the finish.

## Enjoy the Natural Wines of Niki as Part of Your Everyday Life

HARBIOSE is a coined term combining "harmony" and "symbiosis," reflecting a philosophy of thriving together with nature, the community, and future generations. In 2018, the winery acquired and developed abandoned farmland along the Yoichi River in Asahidai, Niki Town. In 2019, they began planting Pinot Noir and Kerner grape varieties.

### Aromatic and Gently Sweet

Made from late-harvested grapes from their own vineyard, their wine offers the natural gentle sweetness of grapes with a perfect balance of acidity.

## Crafting Wines in Harmony with Nature Using High-Quality, Pure Grapes

The vineyard sits at an elevation of 130 to 150 meters on a highland near the Yoichi River, the highest point in Niki. From the vineyard, you can see the townscapes of Niki and Yoichi, Yoichi Bay, and the iconic Cape Shiripa.

### Complex Flavors Combining Fruitness, Rich Acidity, and Umami

This wine features aromas of wafting spices and earthy notes blended with cinnamon. It has gentle tannins, making it easy to drink, and the umami in the finish is particularly memorable.

## A Major Producer's Vision for the Future of Grape Cultivation

Hokkaido Wine's winemaking techniques are rooted in German winemaking methods, which have been further refined and advanced since the company's founding. At the Shiribeshi Vineyard, grapes are cultivated without herbicides, chemical pesticides, or fertilizers under JAS organic standards. They also incorporate smart agriculture, leading the way in modern winemaking.

### This wine combines grape varieties harvested in Hokkaido, primarily those suited for white wine production.

It is a crisp, dry white wine characterized by a subtle floral aroma and refreshing acidity.

## Living by Our Motto — Nothing Added, Nothing Missing

This is a new winery by Very Berry Farm & Winery Niki, the first winery in Japan to receive organic wine certification. They cultivate wine grapes like Pinot Noir, Pinot Gris, and Gewürztraminer, as well as table grapes such as Niagara and Portland, along with hybrid varieties. All are grown using environmentally friendly organic farming methods based on JAS standards.

## From Le Reve ("dream") to Bless A Wine Connecting People

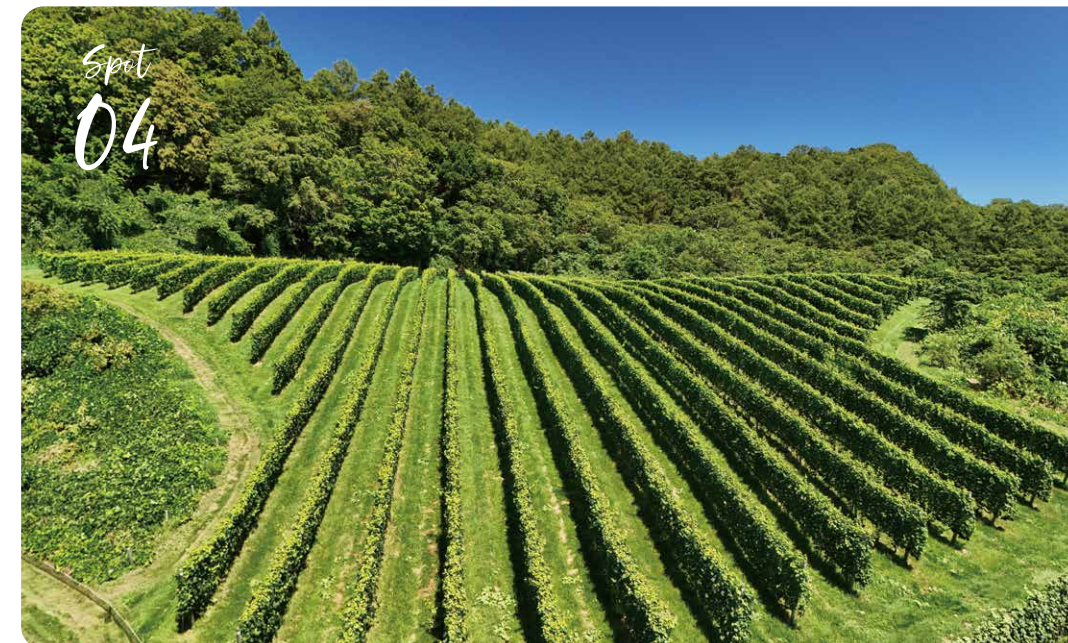

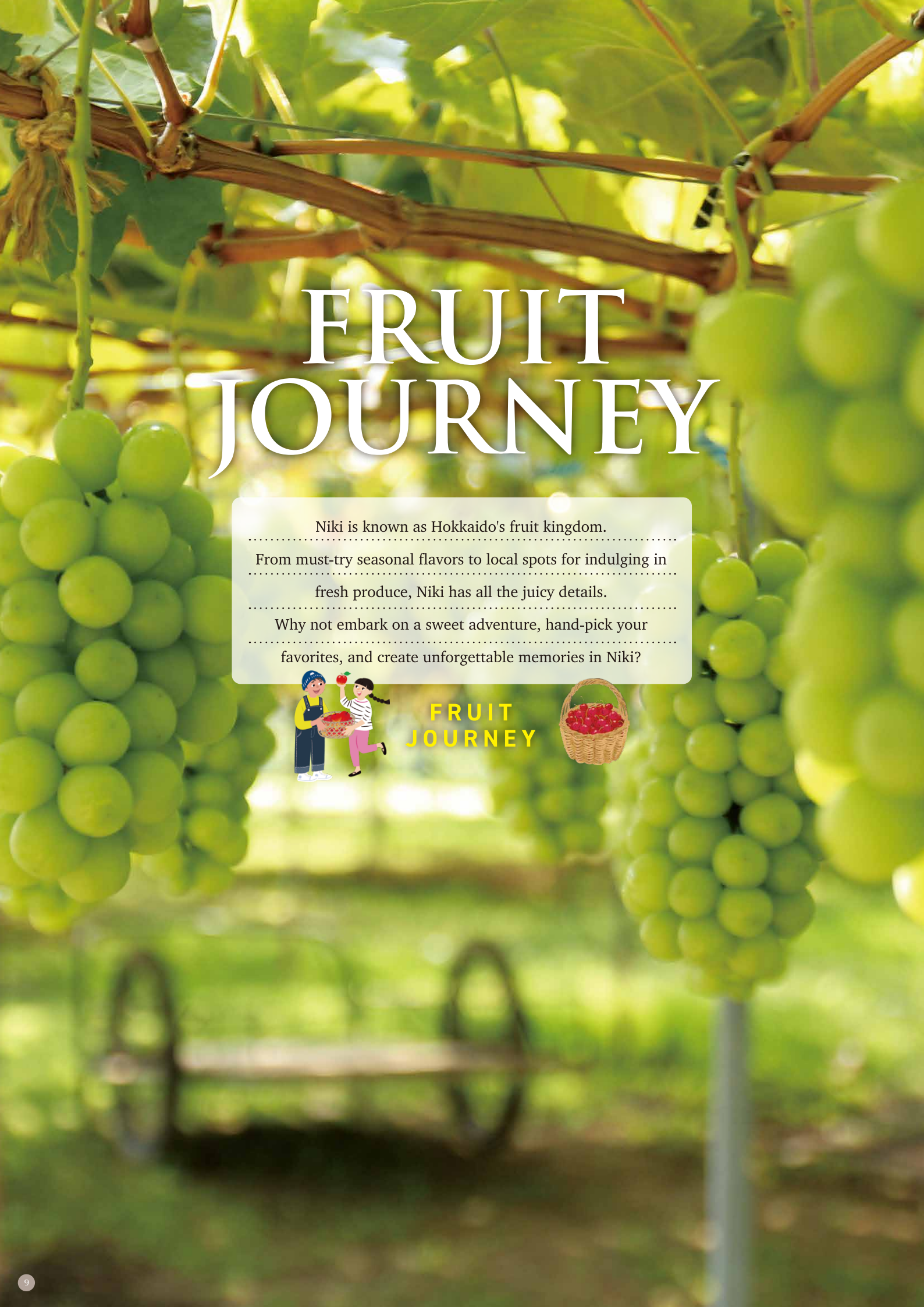

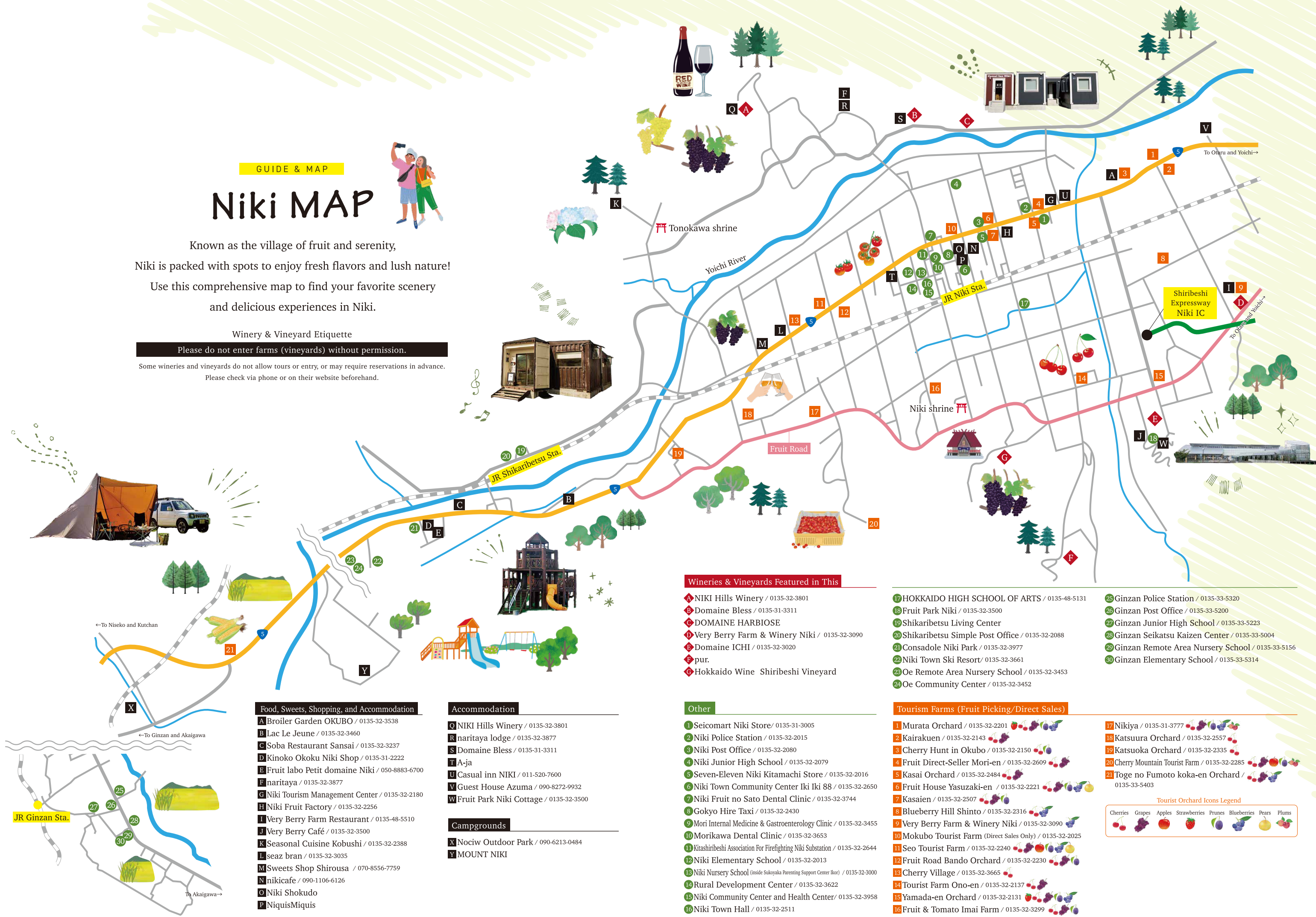
